The Friends of Music at St. Thomas's are proud to present the brilliant Montreal-based viola da gamba duo Les Voix Humaines in concert in the church on Wednesday, June 7 at 7:30 pm. The event will coincide with the ensemble's release of a new recording on the ATMA label entitled *Anguille sous roche – Something Fishy*, featuring delicacies from the French repertoire (Francois Couperin, Marin Marais, Jean-Philippe Rameau), offering humour, virtuosity and tenderness in a unique, creative program.

The Voix Humaines duo brings elegance and brilliance to their performances. Viola da gamba and recorder virtuoso Melisande Corriveau and Susie Napper have performed together for two decades as members of the Les Voix Humaines viol consort, collaborating on numerous concerts and recordings. They both play on 17th century viols from the workshop of the London luthier Barak Norman.
