### **CONFESSIONS DURING LENT**

### REINSTATEMENT OF MATTINS ON SUNDAYS

Morning Prayer is now being offered at 7:30 am, prior to Low Mass. Those attending Morning Prayer are asked to sit in the Quire and to recite the psalms antiphonally by whole verse alternating by side, with those sitting on the same side as the Officiant join in at the second half of the first verse.


