### REINSTATEMENT OF MATTINS ON SUNDAYS

Beginning the First Sunday in Lent, March 6, Morning Prayer will be offered at 7:30 am, prior to Low Mass. Those attending Morning Prayer are asked to sit in the Quire and to recite the psalms antiphonally by whole verse alternating by side, with those sitting on the same side as the Officiant join in at the second half of the first verse.


