**ORGAN RECITAL** – Friday November 12 at 8:00 pm

We are excited to begin to re-open the church for public performances. The first will be on Friday, November 12 at 8:00 pm when we welcome organist Craig Humber who will present works by Bach, Brahms and Reger.

A native of Newfoundland, Craig Humber is a graduate of Acadia University and pursued advanced organ studies in Leipzig and Lübeck in Germany followed by post graduate studies in Vienna, Austria. He has received numerous prizes, scholarships and study grants including from the Royal Canadian College of Organists, the Godfrey Hewitt Memorial Fund, the Anglican Foundation (Fulford Trust), and the Canada Council. He has held a teaching position at the Franz Schubert Conservatory of Music in Vienna and since 2017 has been organist at Vienna's Votivkirche where he curates the church's four organs. He concertizes regularly with recent performances in Austria, Germany, Italy and Spain and was a featured performer at the RCCO Organ Festival in Halifax in 2019.
