# NOTE FROM THE WARDENS RE DIOCESE VACCINATION POLICY

On September 17, 2021, the College of Bishops of the Diocese of Toronto approved a policy of mandatory vaccination for all clergy, employees and volunteers aged 12 or over in parishes of the Diocese -

As stated in Bishop Andrew's pastoral letter of September 14, **proof of vaccination to attend worship in an Anglican church in this Diocese is not required**. In that letter, the Bishop also strongly recommended vaccination for all who are able in order to protect children under 12 who don't yet have vaccinations available to them and the vulnerable that are unable to be vaccinated and for whom this virus poses the greatest risk. We strongly endorse that recommendation. St. Thomas's will continue with screening questions and contact tracing, along with rigorous hygiene practices, masking and physical distancing to protect the health of all who enter our buildings. The Policy went into effect on September 30<sup>th</sup> and is focused on clergy, employees and volunteers. The wardens have been working very hard to obtain the necessary proofs of vaccination from those identified in the parish to whom the Policy applies and thank them for their cooperation.

Thanksgiving is around the corner and the **FRIDAY FOOD MINISTRY** is gearing up to put on its annual Thanksgiving Meal. This is a major undertaking and we need a lot of help to make it happen. Thanksgiving this year falls on Monday, October 11.
