## **GLENN GOULD SCHOOL MUSICIANS IN CONCERT - Tuesday, May 14 at 7 pm**

We have a wonderful opportunity to hear a group of talented music students from the Royal Conservatory's Glenn Gould School (GGS) and support their hard work over the past academic year. Participating are the members of a string quintet (see below), two harpists, a flautist, and an oboe player. Freewill offering.

The **Star Quintet**, which formed in the fall of 2023, comprises four students from the GGS's Bachelor of Music program (Maria Jojatu, Ehrentraud Moser, Savannah Seibel, and Karmen Grubisic) alongside cellist and GGS alumni Emma Schmiedecke. They began their work together by diving into Dohnanyi's imaginative *Piano Quintet No. 1*, and it was one of the building blocks that encouraged their love for quintet repertoire. In their second semester, they explored Shostakovich's *Piano Quintet in G minor, Op.57*, which they say has brought them closer to his music. Throughout the 2023–24 academic year, they were coached by pianist and GGS faculty member David Louie.
